

Ivy House Cornwall B&B – Access Guide

Introduction

Ivy House is a two-storey late-Georgian property dating from the 1830s with many original features. Unfortunately, this means the building is not always suitable for people with very limited mobility or sight impairment. Our Access Guide aims to describe the house and its facilities honestly, to ensure that all our guests will be happy and comfortable during their stay. The following information is provided to help you decide if Ivy House is suitable for your needs.

Arrival & car parking facilities

There is free parking outside Ivy House, a few steps from the front path. We are happy to help unload and carry bags from your car to your room. From the front drive, there are two sets of steps (10 in all, of varying sizes) to the front door and hall – with a handrail at the side of each set of steps. The drive, parking area and front path are tarmac; the path around the front of the house is loose gravel.

If arriving at St Austell train or bus/coach station, Ivy House is a short walk away. If you need help carrying your bags from the station, we are happy to help – please call Ivy House when you arrive. If you have trouble walking, it is possible to take a taxi the very short distance from the station for a small fare.

Main entrance & ground floor

Ivy House has a large hall which gives access to the dining/breakfast room and the living room, which is available for guests to use. There is also a ground floor toilet. For breakfast, guests sit around a large, antique dining room table. There is plenty of room to access the chairs. There is a printed breakfast menu.

Bedrooms

All three guest bedrooms are on the first floor, up one flight of stairs. There are 16 steps in a straight line (no corners or curves) and there is a strong bannister rail. At the top of the stairs, there is a large landing which leads to the bedrooms and bathroom. Bedroom 1 is a large room with a king size bed and basin; there is an en suite bathroom with a walk-in shower (with a seat and grab rail), a basin and a toilet. Bedroom 2 is a large room with a double bed and en suite bathroom with walk-in shower, basin and toilet. Bedroom 3 is a large room with two single beds and a basin. The large bathroom has a bath/shower, a basin and a toilet.

Additional information

If you or any of your party are hearing or sight impaired, please let us know so that we can help in any way we can – for example, with the breakfast menu. If you have any special dietary requirements or food allergies/intolerances, please let us know when booking and/or when signing-in.

Free Wifi is available throughout the house. There is a good mobile phone signal in the local area with 4G.

There is a strict no smoking/vaping policy inside Ivy House.

There are smoke and carbon monoxide alarms in: the kitchen; on the landing; and in all three guest bedrooms, with linked alarms that sound loud, verbal alerts.

We are happy to store medication in the fridge in the kitchen. Please let us know what times it is needed, so we can ensure it is available when required.

There are a number of pharmacies in the town of St Austell, a short walk away, including a branch of Boots the Chemist on the Fore Street.
